### **Scholarship Guidelines:**

The scholarship is for a one time issuance only and is not renewable

Checks for approved candidates are issued jointly to the recipient and the educational institution

Funds are limited to tuition, books and fees

ABWA members or individuals who are members of the ABWA members' household may apply

### **Candidate Eligibility Requirements:**

Women Who:

are citizens of the United States of America and residents of Cape Cod, Martha's Vineyard or Nantucket Island

will be at least second semester level in August 2008

are attending or have been accepted at an accredited college, vocational or technical school

have achieved a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale or verification of achievement

### **Procedures/Checklist:**

Candidate must complete in full the Cape Cod Charter Chapter Scholarship Application

Candidate must provide Cape Cod or Islands address verification (i.e. drivers license, tuition bill, etc.)

Candidate must provide a biographical sketch, no longer than two (2) pages, labelled with her name at the top. The sketch should include information about her background, school activities, outside interests, honors and awards, work experience, community service, etc. Short and long term goals should also be discussed.

Candidate must provide official transcripts for all colleges, vocational or technical school.

Candidate must provide three (3) current letters of reference from persons other than relatives
